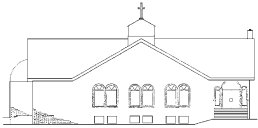

St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina Leadership Scholarship General Information

Purpose:

The St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina Leadership Scholarship was created to recognize and award an individual member of the Greek Community in Regina who is currently enrolled in, or intends to pursue post-secondary education at a recognized institution in Canada or the United States. Candidates will be evaluated on achievements in the areas of academic excellence, leadership, volunteer service to St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community, and an understanding and commitment to living by the core values of the Greek Orthodox Faith.

Two scholarships will be awarded, one for Can\$1000 and one for Can\$500. The award is to be applied to the successful candidate's tuition and/or text books.

Criteria:

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ Must be a member in good standing of St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina, or if under the age of 18, the candidate's parents must be in good standing. (Good standing means that Stewardship Obligation (Dues) has been paid).
- ❖ Must have a minimum grade point average of 70%
- ❖ Must be a degree-seeking student in a registered post-secondary institution in Canada or the United States

Procedure:

Candidates for the scholarships must complete and submit the attached application along with an official transcript to St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina, c/o Scholarship Committee, no later than **July 15**. The selection committee, consisting of the Scholarship Committee Chair, the Community Council Vice-President, the Philoptohos Society Vice-President and the Community Priest will review the applications and identify finalists for the award. Members of the selection committee will interview all finalists.

Candidates will be evaluated based on the proficiency categories listed on the application form. Each of the categories, including the interview, will receive equal weighting in the determination of the successful candidates.
