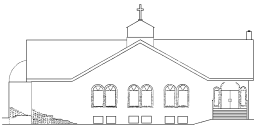

St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina Leadership Scholarship General Information and Application Requirements

Purpose:

The St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina Leadership Scholarship was created to recognize and award an individual member of the Greek Community in Regina who is currently enrolled in or intends to pursue post-secondary education at a recognized institution in Canada or the United States. Candidates will be evaluated on achievements in the areas of leadership, scholarship, volunteer service to St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community, and an understanding and commitment to living by the core values of the Greek Orthodox Faith.

Two scholarships will be awarded, one for CAD\$1000 and one for CAD\$500. The award is to be applied to the successful candidate's tuition and/or textbooks.

Criteria:

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

Must be a member in good standing of St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina, or if under the age of 18, the candidate's parents must be in good standing. (Good standing means that Stewardship Obligation (Dues) has been paid).

Must have a minimum grade point average of 70%.

The school must be a registered post-secondary institution.

Procedure:

Candidates for the scholarships must respond in writing to the attached application along with an official transcript to St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina, c/o Leadership Scholarship Committee. The selection committee, consisting of the Scholarship Committee Chair, the Community Council Vice-President, the Philoptohos Society Vice-President and the Community Priest will review the applications and identify finalists for the award. Members of the selection committee will interview all finalists to determine our winners.

Candidates will be evaluated based on the proficiency categories listed on the attached application requirements form. We wish all candidates good luck!

➤ **Leadership:**

List all leadership-related school activities and any leadership position within the Greek Orthodox Church and Community. This includes Greek School, Sunday School, Dance Group, Altar Boy, Youth Group, MOSAIC, and AHEPA Family.

➤ **Scholarship:**

Outline your post-secondary educational plans including institution, anticipated major field of study, and expected date of completion. Attach the most recent transcript available (may be forwarded at a later date if not immediately available) and list all scholastic awards and honours received during the last two years.

➤ **Volunteer Service:**

List all Church and Community activities for the last five years (Greek School, Sunday School, Altar Boy, Youth Group, MOSAIC, Volunteer or Charitable Organizations, Community Groups) including contact names and phone numbers of the service organization.

➤ **Letters of Recommendation:**

Please include TWO letters of recommendations (Only one may be from another member of St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Community of Regina).

2021 AWARD INSTRUCTIONS: Provide your written responses to St. Paul's Greek Orthodox Church via paper or email NO LATER THAN SEP 15, 2021. Be sure you include a cover letter with your name, address, phone number and email address.
